Dear Christmas Parade Participant,

It's that time of year to again think about and plan for the annual Kiwanis Christmas Parade. This year the parade will be held on **Saturday, December 4, 2010, at 11:00 A.M. PLEASE NOTE THIS IS A DAY TIME PARADE AS IT WAS IN 2009.**

The parade will begin promptly at 11:00 a.m. Parade units will begin lining up at 9:00 a.m. The staging area, the route and ending point remain the same. Please do not arrive in the staging areas prior to 9:00 a.m. This will allow adequate time to position all entrants.

Again this year the parade length will be limited so entries should be made as soon as possible. There will be no professional floats in the parade this year. All entries are expected to reflect the true spirit of Christmas with their decorations. All entries are subject to Kiwanis final approval. You will be notified by phone or email if your entry is rejected for any reason. Approved entries will be notified with a permit letter and staging position prior to November 24, 2010. Inappropriately decorated entries or entries strictly for commercial advertising may be asked to leave.

The same fee schedule is being instituted for participation in the parade this year. Proceeds above expenses, if any, will be used for area children's programs. We hope that you will carefully review the enclosed material, understand the need for these changes, and join us for the 2010 Kiwanis Christmas Parade.

## RULES GOVERNING PARTICIPATION IN THE KIWANIS CHRISTMAS PARADE

### 1. REGISTRATION FEES:

Commercial: For profit businesses, corporations, etc.: \$25.00

Non-commercial: Churches, private groups, non profits, clubs, etc.: \$ 10.00

Public Service Agencies: Police, Fire, Rescue Squads, etc.: No fee is required. But participation should be limited to one or two units or vehicles.

2. PARADE PERMITS: All participant groups and vehicles Must have a parade permit issued by the Kiwanis Club of Abingdon in order to participate in the parade. This permit must be displayed on the float, banner or windshield/dashboard of every vehicle in the parade whether participating as an individual vehicle or pulling a float of other display. Up to three (3) permits will be issued. But you must tell us when you register how many vehicles you will be bringing. The fewer the better, of course.

VEHICLES WITHOUT A PARADE PERMIT WILL NOT BE ADMITTED INTO THE STAGING AREA. THIS INCLUDES VEHICLES JUST DROPPING OFF PARTICIPANTS. Vehicles without a permit will be turned away by the police and Kiwanians manning the entry points. Only the Kiwanis Club of Abingdon has a Town parade permit for this evening and others participating without a permit issued by Kiwanis will be in violation of Town ordinances.

3. Vehicles dropping off participants and picking them up at the end of the parade must leave the staging area ahead of the parade once participants are dropped off. They should proceed to the pick up area on West Main Street by Southern States to await their unit. The street there will be blocked off by the police and there will be ample parking.

4. All units or groups in the parade **MUST** have substantial and appropriate Christmas themed decorations on their floats or displays.\* Merely hanging a wreath on the front of a vehicle is not sufficient. The overall appearance must appear to be Christmas related. \* *This does not apply to vehicles used merely to transport the Grand Marshall, Town officials, dignitaries, etc.*

5. Staggered arrival times and locations will be provided to parade entrants, in so far as possible, when you receive your parade permit and confirmation. Your adherence to this schedule will greatly reduce the congestion and waiting time prior to the parade.

### 6. **THE DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION IS SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2010.**

Registration fee and full information about your entry must be received by this date. A full refund of your entry fee will be made if your entry is not accepted or if received after the maximum of 60 entrants have been approved.

7. **PLEASE, Do not throw candy** from any vehicle or float. Hand the candy to children who otherwise may dart out in front of vehicles to get it. Throwing candy may subject you to being removed from the parade. Please help keep our children and our parade safe. Thanks!
